Staff Review and Public Comment

- Impact Assessment
 - No impacts were identified related to the additional outdoor patio, as there is no change in occupancy or hours of operation and the patio has been operating under the Province's Temporary Expanded Service Area (TESA) program

Recommendation

That Council supports the application of Bard & Banker Pub, located at 1022 Government Street, to licence an existing 80-person outdoor patio area (currently licenced under the Province's Temporary Expanded Service Area (TESA) program) under the establishment's existing liquor primary licence, conditional on the following:

- The establishment having a total occupant load of 320 people, which includes two unenclosed outdoor patios with a seating capacity of 99 including the proposed 80-person outdoor patio.
- Maintaining daily hours of service from 9 a.m. to 1 a.m. inside and 9 a.m. to 11 p.m. on all patios.
