

CYBER CRIME DETECTION

UNSOLICITED CONTACT

Be wary of unexpected emails, calls, text messages asking for personal information. Hang up and contact the organization directly if unsure.



TOO GOOD TO BE TRUE

Scammers often promise free gifts or money. Avoid offers that require payment upfront or seem unrealistic.



PRESSURE TACTICS

Scammers may try to create urgency. Legitimate organizations won't pressure you. Take your time to verify information.
