- Appointed: Mr. Howard Tran
- Coordinates VicPD, City, Island Health, housing & community partners
- Priority: Reduce wait times for Mental Health Act apprehensions
- Deliverables: Framework, monthly reports, final evaluation (Mar 2026)

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## Data & Training

- Empirical Data & Call Analysis
  - Focus: mental health, overdoses, street disorder
- Drug Policy & CDSA
  - Training Launch: Nov 2025
  - Supports health-centred, clear and consistent response

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## Community Policing Initiatives

- Beat/Bikes Team (Jan 2026): visible, proactive patrols
- Bylaw Partnership (Jan 2026): two officers embedded with City staff
- Goals: engagement, disorder response, joint action

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## Recruitment Initiative

- Address retirements & evolving needs
- Support CSWB programs & diversity
- Launch campaign: Jan 2026; ongoing
- Deliverables: campaigns, partnerships, annual report

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## Timeline Highlights

- Sept 2025: CSWB Liaison appointed
- Fall 2025: Data collection, policy review, officer training
- Jan 2026: Beat/Bikes, Bylaw officers, recruitment campaign
