I am against the building of a brewery as it affects the air quality. I do not want to smell yeast in the air. We also do not need yet another alcohol distribution place as there are many within walking distance.

Zoning Regulation Bylaw, Amendment Bylaw (No.1152) N. 18-055

Dockside District distillery and liquor retail store zoning.

Comment:

I understood when purchasing at Dockside 8 years ago, that buildings along the roadside would be not taller than three storeys high. This will impact our views.

I am concerned with the smells of a brewery when producing the product.

My main concern is that placing an open seating area on the roof means that we will be hearing music and noises associated with running a business in the open. We are subjected to the noise of the shipyard during the day but I accept that the shipyard has been an integral part of the neighbourhood. However, I value that I can have quiet evenings and nights to enjoy. We do hear music from the Canoe Pub which is some distance away and so it is unrealistic to imagine that we will not be disturbed nightly from the noises of a rooftop social area so close to our residence. A 'glass enclosure' is not going to be sufficient to protect us from the noise. Please address this issue seriously.

I am not in favour of a pub so close to my residence. Noise and smells are going to be continuous and ongoing and that is a negative impact on those of us living in the area.
