WHEREAS	Ride for Refuge is an experiential event which happens each year on the last Saturday before Thanksgiving across Canada to give participants a personal idea of what it's like to seek refuge; and
WHEREAS	Ride for Refuge brings changes and improvements in the lives of individuals and families throughout the Capital Region District; and
WHEREAS	Ride for Refuge has been an annual event in Victoria, since 2014; and
WHEREAS	September 29, 2018 has been designated as Ride for Refuge Day to provide far-reaching impact, care for people, touch lives and bring hope.

NOW, THEREFORE I do hereby proclaim Saturday, September 29th, 2018 as "RIDE FOR REFUGE DAY" on the TRADITIONAL TERRITORIES of the ESQUIMALT AND SONGHEES FIRST NATIONS in the CITY OF VICTORIA, CAPITAL CITY of the PROVINCE of BRITISH COLUMBIA.
