WHEREAS	the month of April is proclaimed Sikh Heritage Month by the Province of British Columbia; and
WHEREAS	on April 28th, the Vaisakhi celebration will take place at Gurdwara Singh Sabha, showcasing the Sikh community through prayer, followed by a parade and food for everyone to enjoy
WHEREAS	Today, the City of Victoria seeks to recognize the diversity of its community and afford all residents the opportunity to better understand, recognize and appreciate the rich history and shared experiences
