

Local emerging artists partner with at-risk youth to create self portraits at the Greater Victoria Art Gallery


- Fall intake took place between September 1st and October 15th

- We continue to have conversations with residents all year, discussing possible ideas for this program





34 applications were received

- 18 placemaking projects
- 16 activity projects
- 5 are recommended for decline as per table three
- 29 grants recommended for funding for a total request of \$52,945 for the Fall intake
