

Staff Review:

- 30 days to provide comment

Staff Review and Public Comment

Staff Review:

- 2330 Government was recently rezoned to accommodate the use.
- Business and Community Relations and Bylaw did not express concern for the application.
- Police have limited concern, but cannot support the application due to resource pressures.

Public Comment:

- Five letters were received, four in support and one opposed to the application, and the Burnside Gorge Resident's Association did not provide comment.

Recommendation

That Council direct staff to notify the Liquor and Cannabis Regulation Branch that Council supports the application to have a lounge endorsement added to the manufacturing license for a brewery, having hours of operation from 9:00 am to 11:00 pm daily with an occupant load of 86 people.
