A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA

The purpose of this Bylaw is to designate the exterior and portions of the interior of the 1955 chapel building located at 952 Johnson Street and 1400 Vancouver Street to be protected heritage property. The interior elements include:

1. Exposed interior glulam roof beams with metal tie rod supports.
2. Clerestory glazing.
3. Interior projecting canopy over the entrance to the chapel area.

Under its statutory powers, including Section 611 of the *Local Government Act*, the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of Victoria enacts the following provisions:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the “HERITAGE DESIGNATION (952 JOHNSON STREET & 1400 VANCOUVER STREET) BYLAW”.
2. The building located at 952 Johnson Street and 1400 Vancouver Street, legally described as Lot A, District Lots 832, 833, 834 and 835, Victoria City, Plan 13740, is designated to be protected heritage property.
