#### Abstract

WHEREAS diabetes is a serious condition affecting more than 425 million people worldwide; and WHEREAS 11 million Canadians live with diabetes or prediabetes, meaning one in three Canadians either has diabetes or prediabetes; and

WHEREAS 520000 British Columbians currently live with diabetes; and WHEREAS the cost of diabetes in British Columbia is approximately $\$ 509$ million and is expected to rise to $\$ 685$ million by 2029; and

WHEREAS there is a great need to raise funds for research into better methods of treatment, and ultimately a cure; and

WHEREAS Diabetes Canada is leading the fight against diabetes by helping people with diabetes live healthy lives while it works to find a cure; and

WHEREAS maintaining positive health and wellness can in many cases lead to the prevention of prediabetes and type 2 diabetes as well as better diabetes management; and

WHEREAS World Diabetes Day this year focuses on a nationwide diabetes strategy, Diabetes $360^{\circ}$, and British Columbia will work on developing a provincial strategy modelled on the Diabetes $360^{\circ}$ framework; and

WHEREAS Diabetes Canada encourages governmental and non-governmental organizations to recognize World Diabetes Day to raise public awareness of diabetes and its related complications.
