3	Out There Festival	Alter Arts Society	\$5,000	\$3,875	An interactive community art festival in and around Quadra Village, including an audio tour of murals, installations by local artists in front yards, balconies and windows, and the creation of a map of all the temp and permanent installations.
4	Tiny Fall Festival	Fairfield Gonzales Community Association	\$2,450	\$1,200	Annual Fairfield Fall event but smaller with pop up concerts around the neighbourhood, craft workshops, booths and food trucks etc. Takes place in Porter Park on Aug 29th.
