Subject: BC Transit Bus Tickets for Persons Sheltering Outdoors

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

That Council receive this report for information.

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

On November 12, 2020 Council approved funding up to \$2,812.50 per month for 3 months to the Community Social Planning Council's BC Transit Ticket Assistance Program and to bring to Council a review of this program after 3 months. All funds as approved have been issued. Should Council wish to continue the program, direction to do so, including a funding source, would accomplish this.

The Community Social Planning Council partnered with PEERS as the operational lead on this project to help with the distribution as it was determined they had the ability to reach the community sheltering outdoors in Victoria. Staff have worked with both organizations to coordinate the distribution plan of these ticket based on the need, request and statistics of tickets issued.

One book of bus tickets contains 25 sheets, and each sheet holds 10 individual bus tickets. The standard cost of a bus ticket sheet is \$22.50, so one book of bus tickets costs \$562.50. Since the BC Transit Ticket Program matches on a 1:1 basis, this results in double the number of tickets received. The maximum funding amount of \$2,812.50 results in 10 books or 2,500 individual tickets.

Three installments of \$2,812.50 have been issued since December which translates into 30 books or 7,500 tickets being distributed to the community sheltering outdoors. The tables below provided by PEERS demonstrate the distribution statistics for the first two installments. The statistics for the final month will be available after the end of March.
