Subject: Bylaw for Parks Regulation Amendment Bylaw

RECOMMENDATION

That the following bylaw be given first, second and third readings:

- Parks Regulation Bylaw, Amendment Bylaw (No. 15)

BACKGROUND

Attached for Council's initial consideration is a copy of the proposed Bylaw No. 21-049

The issue came before Council on March 18, 2021 where the following resolution was approved:

Parks Amendment Bylaw

1. That Council instruct the City Solicitor to bring forward bylaw amendments necessary to continue the permanent prohibition on sheltering in Centennial Square, Central Park and Cecelia Ravine Park in time for adoption prior to May 1, 2021, with the prohibition in Central Park being reviewed at a time when 940 Caledonia Temporary Use Permit expires should that application be approved.
2. That Council instruct the City Solicitor to bring forward bylaw amendments necessary to continue the temporary regulations regarding location, size, and distancing of shelters to continue until the end of the pandemic in time for adoption prior to May 1, 2021.
3. That Council instruct staff to bring forward bylaw amendments to restore the opportunity for the members of the public to use BBQs responsibly in municipal parks.
