At the Committee of the Whole meeting on January 21, 2021, Council requested the maps which have been developed to identify the areas in parks which are at high risk of flooding. Staff will complete further technical assessment of the areas identified and monitor any changes over time. Once the assessments have been completed, all relevant communication material will be updated, including park signage, and shared with individuals sheltering in parks as well as social service providers.


