Please note that as a resident of 595 Pandora Avenue, we experience excessive noise during the summer months from the brew pub in Market Square, and from patrons emerging from The Drake Pub. Increasing the capacity and opening hours as submitted will greatly exacerbate this disturbance - which has been detrimental to our healthy sleep patterns.

Given the stresses associated with COVID-19, late night bar activity that disturbs sleep will have a detrimental effect on residents nearby. I'm frankly surprised that given the pandemic and the associated health restrictions, that increased occupancy is being tabled for discussion. Drinking only increases the risk of transmission due to inhibitions surrounding social distancing and mask wearing. Considering how limited my almost non-existent gym class participation numbers are (8) given the mandated restrictions, I'm shocked that a total of 167 people drinking alcohol until midnight is a consideration at this time. Regardless, even post-COVID 19 extending the closing hours until midnight and increasing occupancy will mean excessive noise from intoxicated patrons that typically shout until long after closing.

Hello. I received today a letter dated February 10, 2021 from the City of Victoria inviting comments on an application by Whistle Buoy Brewing Company for an increase of occupancy of 55 people in the exterior patio and interior space.

I live at 595 Pandora Avenue which is almost next to the Whistlebuoy operation. Not only does Whistlebuoy operate a drinking establishment but it also has brewing tanks on the upper floor. I cannot understand how they have permission to manufacture beer on the roof of the building, which is preventing those on the upper floor of 595 Pandora Avenue from sleeping at night on account of the operation of the tanks and fans. If Whistlebuoy is prepared to install screens that reduce the environmental noise impact of the brewing tanks, at least that would be a first step.

Our condominium is across a parking lot from Market Square and Whistlebuoy. Another pub, Swans, has a similar application for increased sitting capacity at its operation across the street, which I oppose for the same reasons. There is also The Drake just down the street. There are already problems with drinking, drunks, break-ins and vandalism around our condo. I cannot see that increasing the seating capacity will advance the neighbourhood in any form. And of course it will be worse when the pandemic ends and people are free to make more noise than now.

We need more police presence, not more drinking. So please, NO to Whistlebuoy until it demonstrates it is a good neighbour citizen, shuts down or lessens the impact of its brewing, and gives the residents of the neighbourhood more respect!

Dear Mayor Helps and Council,

The DRA Land Use Committee has reviewed the application for a structural change to a Manufacturers Licence to:

1. Expand the interior Tap Room space into the adjoining unit (an additional 616 sqft);
2. Introduce a transiting corridor to allow patrons to carry drinks from the Tap Room to the Patio; and,
3. Increase the occupant load on the patio by 55 people concurrent with a patio expansion: increasing the total occupancy from 112 to 167 people.

We understand that the existing hours of operation Monday to Wednesday 11AM to 11PM and Thursday to Sunday 11AM to 12AM will remain the same.

Feedback from the committee is as follows:

- Whistle Buoy seems to be a well-run business in a location without adjoining residential. Because of these two important factors, the request for increased capacity is supportable.
- The expansion into an adjoining unit within Market Square makes it a relatively contained location with no direct implications for residential buildings. This application for expansion seems unproblematic.
- There are several restaurants in Market Square but there shouldn't be any conflict between those operators.
- This seems like a good application. They encourage takeout from the nearby restaurants, so this might be a boon for the food places.
- Whistle Buoy has been in operation for almost 2 years and unless there are complaints from neighbouring residents, or a history of complaints registered with VicPD, this

application seems reasonable. The operators have a proven track record and have been open, transparent and responsive to the community.

In absence of the long-anticipated Municipal Alcohol Policy, the LUC developed and the DRA ratified, the DRA Policy for Liquor Primary & Late Night Food Primary Liquor Licences in February 2020. All relevant liquor applications are reviewed on the basis on this policy and our assessment of the application's performance is included below.

- Proximity to residential buildings and units has not been an issue historically and is not anticipated to be a problem if the proposed changes are implemented.
- With an exit on both Johnson and Pandora Streets and no change in hours, the patron noise when exiting will continue to be distributed.
- While the application seeks about a 50% increase in capacity, the total capacity at this location is not considered problematic particularly due to its siting interior to Market Square and the hours of operation.
- Support for this application has been provided by LUC members and we have not received any communication expressing concerns either by LUC members or members of the community.

DRA LUC members strongly support a vibrant downtown and remain concerned about the increasing number and concentration of late night liquor primary seats not just in Downtown but in this area specifically. However, we consider this application stands apart from those concerns due to operational context. As such, the DRA LUC finds that this application is supportable.

The Victoria Downtown Residents Association’s Land Use Committee (“LUC”) has been extremely consistent in expressing concerns regarding Food Primary Applications that propose to operate after midnight and Liquor Primary Applications within the Downtown Harris Green Community. As residents, we support an active, dynamic community with a diversity of entertainment and business operations. In addition, we support the long-term coexistence of residential uses and business operations. The following policy provides clarity to community stakeholders regarding the parameters the LUC uses to assess each application. The LUC may withhold support for an application if any of the following aspects are not adequately addressed.

1. Proximity to residential buildings and units

Sufficient separation between licenced venues and residential units is required to ensure liveability for residents and the successful coexistence of licenced operations and residents. Support may be withheld for applications that propose inserting licenced venues proximal to residential units. We may decline to support any liquor application that is proposed to be located in an existing residential building. (Likewise, we do not provide wholesale support for the creation of residential units adjacent to established licenced venues without comprehensive mitigation strategies.)

2. Sound mitigation

Support may be withheld for applications that have not properly mitigated noise impacts on effected residential units through proper design and soundproofing assemblies with consideration for whether neighbouring residential units have sufficient window Sound Transmission Class Ratings and air-conditioning.

3. Capacity (Indoor seating)

Support for an application may be withheld if the requested capacity is expected to negatively impact the residential community. EG. Large capacity operations with late night hours of operation adjacent to residential units will not be supported.

4. Days and hours of operation (Indoor seating)

An application may be supported if the days and hours of operation are not expected to negatively impact the residential community.

5. Excess patron noise

Late Night Food Primary and Liquor Primary operations often come with associated nuisance noise, such as patrons congregating on the street, yelling, and smoking, etc, patrons exiting en masse on closing, and interior noise related to capacity. An application may be supported if excess patron noise is not expected to negatively impact the residential community.

- 6. Outdoor seating (Patio or Sidewalk): proximity, capacity and hours of operation**

Hours of operation for outdoor seating areas may be regulated differently than for the related indoor operations. An application may be supported if the capacity and hours of operation for outdoor seating areas are not expected to negatively impact the residential community. The proximity of residential units to outdoor seating areas will be assessed on a case-by-case basis in terms of the potential impact.
- 7. Late night hours – rationale and justification required for both Liquor and Food Primary**

Support for late night hours may be withheld if an applicant does not supply their rationale and justification for extended hours. These will be assessed on a case-by-case basis in terms of the potential impact on the residential community.
- 8. Patron participation**

Support for the inclusion of patron participation will be assessed on a case-by-case basis relative to the other aspects of this policy.
- 9. Entertainment endorsement**

Support for the inclusion of entertainment endorsement will be assessed on a case-by-case basis relative to the other aspects of this policy.
- 10. Implications of licencing in perpetuity**

Support for an application will consider the potential long-term impact of the existence of the licence beyond the proposed business model and current operator/applicant.
- 11. Food service strategy (Food primary licences)**

Applications for new food primary liquor licences requesting late operating hours will also be reviewed on the basis of their food service strategy. Support may be withheld if an application does not demonstrate that food service is the focus of the operation after midnight. Food primary applications for venues that intend to effectively operate as liquor primary venues will not be supported.
- 12. Food Primary Licences: Sales records**

Applicants are requested to demonstrate that food service will remain the focus of their operations. Support for the extension of operating hours for existing food primary liquor licences will be determined on the basis of sales records for food and alcoholic beverages for evening hours. Food primary venues that intend to effectively operate as liquor primary venues in the late night will not be supported.
- 13. Level of support of residents**

Support or concerns expressed by residents in the neighbourhood through letters and emails also inform the LUC and will shape the level of support for applications.
