RECOMMENDATION

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The City has been receiving funding from Emergency Management BC (EMBC) to support shower facilities at Our Place. Approvals have been granted one month at a time and the City has been required to request extensions each month.

On November 20, 2020, the City was advised that the extension for December was denied because the City has received a grant from the Province that can be used to cover revenue losses, additional costs related to the pandemic, and cost related to services for vulnerable persons. Therefore, EMBC funding for services for vulnerable populations is no longer available. Council directed staff to report back if EMBC funding were denied. As a result of this denial for funding, the shortfall is \$10,000 per month.

Council has yet to provide direction for the use of the provincial grant, and this is scheduled to be part of the budget discussion for 2021 that are currently underway. As discussed during the initial meeting, this funding was planned to be part of the mitigation strategies that could achieve Council's direction for a tax increase of no more than inflation plus 1%.
