EXECUTIVE SUMMARY


At the Council meeting of November 12, 2020, Council established the Emergency Social Services Grant and allocated up to \$100,000 from the federal-provincial Restart funding to initiate a one-time grant program to deliver mobile hygiene and other social services.

The grant is open to not-for-profit organizations and informal groups. Informal groups are to include a letter of support from a registered not-for-profit organization.

The 10 applications submitted are included as Attachment A.


