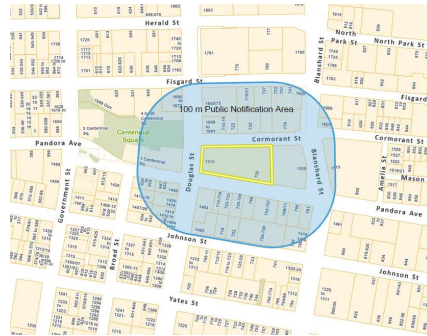

Local Government

Staff Review:

- Police, Bylaw, Planning, Business and Community Relations and Engineering
- Zoning regulation, liquor policy and the Liquor Licencing Fee Bylaw

Public Notification and Comment:

- Notice Posted at entrance to establishment
- Mailed Notice to within 100m of establishment
- 30 days to provide comment

Local Government provides a resolution with comment on:

- Potential for Noise
- Potential for Impact on the Community

Staff Review and Public Comment

Staff Review:

- 1515 Douglas Street
- The surrounding area does not have a high concentration of licenced establishments.
- Reduced patio hours would be appropriate to mitigate impacts resulting from the patio
- Police are concerned about the hours and occupant load in conjunction with the entertainment endorsement being consistent with conditions associated with nightclubs.

Public Comment:

- Letters were sent to 747 owners and occupants
- In response, 13 letters were received where 11 expressed concern including a letter from the Downtown Residents Association and the remaining two expressed support for the application.

Recommendation

That Council direct staff to notify the Liquor and Cannabis Regulation Branch that Council supports the recommended hours of 9am to 1am each day for the interior space and 9am to 12am each day for the exterior patio where the occupant load is 177 people including a 38 person outdoor patio and having a patron participation entertainment endorsement for Toptable Victoria at 1515 Douglas Street.
