- 1. That Council authorize the issuance of Temporary Use Permit Application No. 00020 for 320 Cook Street and 1075 Pendergast Street expiring three years from the date of this resolution, in accordance with plans submitted to the Sustainable Planning and Community Development department and date stamped by Planning on December 14, 2021, to permit commercial use of the upper storey of the existing building, subject to the following conditions:
  - a. no less than 3 parking spaces shall be provided for the use;

- b. the owner enters into a legally binding agreement with BC Transit to the satisfaction of the Director of Planning by which the owner shall purchase 9 annual EcoPASSes per year for 3 years for use by the occupants of the building; and
- c. the owner provides evidence of payment of the full amount of the EcoPasses to BC Transit or security to the City, in form and substance to the satisfaction of the Director of Planning, as a letter of credit in an amount equal to the total cost of the EcoPASSes delivered prior to the issuance of the Temporary Use Permit.
