## E. LAND USE MATTERS

#### E.1 <u>937 View Street - Development Permit with Variances No. 00051</u> (Downtown)

Council received a report dated May 13, 2022 from the Director of Sustainable Planning and Community Development regarding an application for a 19-storey residential building with approximately 266 rental units. Two variances from the existing zone are proposed and relate to an increase in the maximum height from 27m to 60.15m and an increase in the maximum number of storeys from 9 to 19 storeys.

Committee discussed the following:

- Proposed zero parking variance
- Excessive density proposed on the lot
- Previous iterations of the proposed application
- Possibility of applicant consolidating their proposals
- Impacts of multiple setback requests on the proposal, including increased building height
- Proposed residential rental tenure
- Willingness on the part of the applicant to pursue further revisions
- Staff time which will be consumed per a referral
- Challenges with the currently designated zoning on the parcel
- Shading impacts on the surrounding area, particularly on the proposed urban plaza to the north
