

STREETS AND TRAFFIC BYLAW, AMENDMENT BYLAW (NO. 12)

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA

The purpose of this Bylaw is to amend the *Streets and Traffic Bylaw No. 09-079* to impose a fee to cover the City's costs in replacing or restoring survey monuments damaged by persons during the course of construction or any other activity, where such monuments are located within City streets, sidewalks, boulevards, or public places.

Under its statutory powers, including sections 8(3)(b), 35, 36 and 194 of the *Community Charter*, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Victoria in an open meeting assembled enacts the following provisions:

Title

- 1 This Bylaw may be cited as the "Streets and Traffic Bylaw, Amendment Bylaw (No. 12)".

Amendments

- 2 The Streets and Traffic Bylaw No. 09-079, is amended:
 - (a) in the Table of Contents, by adding the following immediately after "106 Works on street require permit":

"106A Damage to survey monument fee"
 - (b) in the preamble (a) after the Table of Contents, by adding "194," after the number "64".
 - (c) by inserting the following new section immediately after section 106:

"Damage to survey monuments fee"

106A A person who damages, destroys, or moves a survey monument located within a street, sidewalk, boulevard, or public place, must pay the City a fee of \$2,000 to replace or restore the survey monument."

Commencement

- 3 This Bylaw comes into force on adoption.
