Six million Canadians 1 in 5 live every day with the fire of arthritis and there is no cure. Without a greater spotlight on this growing issue, the number of Canadians with arthritis will rise to nine million by 2040; and
- WHEREAS During Arthritis Awareness Month this September, we seek to raise voices and awareness, and we are encouraging everyone who lives with arthritis and all those who know and love them to fight the fire of arthritis;
- **WHEREAS** the Arthritis Society is Canada's national charity dedicated to extinguishing arthritis for good.
