



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





















### Heritage Value

#### **Character-Defining Elements** (selected)

- location on an alleyway, which allows for windows on the east façade.
- the contribution of the exterior brick walls to the Klondike-era courtyard at the rear.
- storefront, cast-iron columns and large windows with transoms, which allow for a well-lit interior.
- decorative façade, including: incised scrolled ornamentation, "W.G. Cameron" name plate, the prominent cornice, and the arch above the two central windows.

- upper storey double-hung woodensash windows.
- the integrity of the building envelope, which identifies it as a nineteenth-century commercial building





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
