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LGA and **LUPB**


- LGA enables delegation of DPs (w/o variances)
- 2021: LGA amended to also enable delegation of DVPs
- LUPB delegates authority to make decisions

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DPV vs **DVP**

- DPV = Design guidelines apply
- DVP = No design guidelines. Just variances to zoning



OCP Map 32: Development Permit Areas

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Current Delegated DPVs

- Vehicle stalls ≤ 5
- Bicycle stalls ≤ 6
- Accessible parking
- RDAH

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Potential Benefits

- Reduced processing times and fees
- Fewer applications at Council meetings
- Reduced resources required
- Advance housing applications more quickly

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Potential Variance Examples

- Setbacks to stairs, porches and eaves
- Site coverage for accessibility ramps
- Height of underground parking stalls
- Distance from parking stall to street

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Options

- Option One Seek Focused Input and Prepare Bylaws to Expand Delegated Authority (Recommendation)
- Option Two Direct staff to Expand Delegation without Seeking Input
- Option Three Do not Expand Delegated Authority

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Recommendation

That Council direct staff to:

- Seek input from the Urban Development Institute and Community
 Association Land Use Committees relating to the delegation of minor
 variances.
- 2. Prepare draft Land Use Procedures Bylaw amendments to delegate minor variances associated with Development Variance Permits, Development Permits and Heritage Alteration Permits to the Director of Sustainable Planning and Community Development.
- 3. Bring forward the draft Land Use Procedures Bylaw amendments for Council's consideration along with any feedback received.

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
