

PATIO REGULATION BYLAW, AMENDMENT BYLAW (NO. 1)

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA

The purpose of this Bylaw is to amend the *Patio Regulation Bylaw* to extend the date by which a business that held a permit under the Business Recovery from Pandemic Bylaw 20-072 on March 30, 2023 may occupy a sidewalk or street on the terms of that permit and in accordance with the requirements of that bylaw.

Under its statutory powers, including section 14 of the Victoria City Act, 1919 and sections 8(3), 15, 19, 35, 36, 38, 154 and 194 of the *Community Charter*, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Victoria in an open meeting assembled enacts the following provisions:

Title

- 1 This Bylaw may be cited as the “PATIO REGULATION BYLAW, AMENDMENT BYLAW (NO. 01)”.

Amendments

- 2 Bylaw No. 23-035, the Patio Regulation Bylaw, is amended in section 31 as follows:
 - (a) By deleting “May 31” and replacing it with “November 30”; and
 - (b) In subsection (b) by deleting “May 5” and replacing it with “September 29”.

Commencement

- 3 This Bylaw comes into force on adoption.
