- Operational Restructure 2-year pilot
 - Increased Patrol resources
 - General Investigation Section
 - Co-Response Team launch
 - Partners registered mental health clinicians with plain-clothes officers
 - Handled ~250 files in Q1

- Notable Themes:
 - Targeting crime: Over \$190,000 in stolen goods, kilograms of illicit substances & weapons seized across multiple files
 - Crimes against persons: Officers respond to multiple random assaults, high risk offender, homicide suspect and arson suspect arrested.
