

- □ Operational Restructure 2-year pilot

 - □ Handled ~250 files in Q1

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Operational Update

- □ Notable Themes:
 - □ Targeting crime: Over \$190,000 in stolen goods, kilograms of illicit substances & weapons seized across multiple files
 - Crimes against persons: Officers respond to multiple random assaults, high risk offender, homicide suspect and arson suspect arrested.
