PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to outline terms of reference for Councillors assigned to a City neighbourhood.

<u>APPLICATION</u>

1. This Policy applies to each Councillor's term when assigned to a City neighbourhood.

POLICY STATEMENTS

Assignments

- 2. Neighbourhood assignments are established by Council on the recommendation of the Mayor.
- 3. The Mayor must make reasonable effort to ensure Councillors are assigned to neighbourhoods in which they do not reside at the time of their assignment.

Term

- 4. Assignments are for a two-year period made near the beginning of Council's term.
- 5. The Mayor must review the assignments at the end of the two-year period with recommendations to renew or to adjust accordingly.

Roles and Responsibilities

- 6. Councillors with neighbourhood assignments must
 - (a) learn about the neighbourhood's values, history, and concerns,
 - (b) act as a link between neighbourhood residents and Council.
- 7. Councillors with neighbourhood assignments may
 - (a) attend neighbourhood association meetings, land use committee meetings and other community events of interest,
 - (b) take action on neighbourhood issues by way of Council Member Motion if the Councillor determines it requires Council's attention.
