Subject: Housing Agreement for 722/726 Discovery Street

RECOMMENDATION

That Housing Agreement (722 and 726 Discovery Street) Bylaw (2024) No. 24-016 be given first, second and third reading.

BACKGROUND

Attached for Council's initial consideration is a copy of proposed Bylaw No. 24-016. The issue came before Council at a Public Hearing held on June 29, 2023 where the proposal for an eight-storey, multi-unit residential building consisting of approximately 90 supportive housing dwelling units was approved in principle and where Council provided the following direction:

- a) all dwelling units remain below-market rental for 60 years, or the life of the building, whichever is greater;
- b) all dwelling units are to be operated by a non-profit or government agency for 60 years, or the life of the building, whichever is greater, to guarantee that the development will continue to provide non-market housing.

The City has received the satisfactory executed Housing Agreement from the applicant.
