

28 Bastion Square

AKA The Courthouse, AKA Victoria Law Courts

- → 1888/89: Constructed: "The Provincial Courthouse is a significant and formidable landmark in Bastion Square."
- → 1960s: Centrepiece of "urban renewal" (see also Centennial Sq)
- → 1965 to 2014: Home to the Maritime Museum of BC
- → 1977: City transferred ownership to province with understanding it would continue as a museum.
- → 2014 to 2024: 10 years CLOSED

This building is owned by the Province of British Columbia
