GOVERNANCE

Silver Threads Service has a professional, volunteer Board of Directors that provides leadership to the organization.

We have written Financial and Governance Policies, a regularly reviewed and monitored Strategic Plan, Board Orientation and Training.

The Board has expertise in accounting, human resources, fundraising, charitable work and provides expertise to the Executive Director.

FINANCIAL HEALTH

Diversified funding is critical for charities

In our 2023-2024 fiscal year end our operating revenue was \$780,813

Only 34% is membership and program fees

The other 66% comes for other sources that include:

Grants, Foundations, Gaming

VOLUNTEERS AND STAFF

In addition to our Volunteer Board of Directors Silver Threads Service has 70 volunteers who support programs and services. From our Food Security Programs, to supporting programs and events, Senior Mentoring and Support Programs.
