Staff Review and Public Comment

- Impact Assessment
 - The business has recently completed exterior renovations.
 - · The application would align existing capacity with the renovated layout.
 - Late-night outdoor service hours would be reduced, and amplified music would end by 11 p.m.
- Public Comment
 - · Letters were sent to 419 owners and occupants
 - In response, 15 letters were received; 10 were opposed and 5 were supportive
 - A letter from the Downtown Residents Association requested that the establish monitor and modulate noise before approvals are granted

Recommendation

That Council direct staff to notify the Liquor and Cannabis Regulation Branch that Council supports the application of Craft Beer Market, located at 450 Swift Street, to consolidate their two liquor primary licences, change the service hours associated with the licence, and change the distribution of the existing occupant load:

- The establishment having a total occupant load of 786 people where 355 are interior (195 food primary / 160 liquor primary), and 431 are exterior (276 food primary / 155 liquor primary).
- Interior food primary and liquor primary hours are 9 a.m. to 1 a.m. Monday to Saturday and 9 a.m. to 12 a.m. Sunday.
- Exterior food primary and liquor primary hours are 9 a.m. to 11 p.m. Friday and Saturday and 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. Sunday to Thursday.
- No exterior amplified music is permitted after 11 p.m. Friday and Saturday and after 10 p.m. Sunday to Thursday.
