A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA

The purpose of this Bylaw is to designate the exterior of the house (built in 1912) located on the southernmost portion of the property at 1120 Faithful Street to be protected heritage property.

Under its statutory powers, including Section 611 of the *Local Government Act*, the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of Victoria enacts the following provisions:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the “HERITAGE DESIGNATION (1120 FAITHFUL STREET) BYLAW”.
2. The house (built in 1912) located on the southernmost portion of the property at 1120 Faithful Street, legally described as Lots 5 and 6, Fairfield Farm Estate, Victoria City, Plan 1095, is designated to be protected heritage property.
