Community Engagement Efforts

- 106 community meetings

- Bike Registry Program (200 bikes added to the 1,700 already registered)
- Fraud Prevention Month (March)
- Distracted Driving Month (March)



Operational Priorities

- Operational priorities coordinated through Strategic Operations Council
 - ▣ January
 - 700-block of Johnson St: Calls were static, increase in property crime.
 - St. Charles St/Richmond Rd: 22% drop in calls for service.
 - ▣ February
 - Fernwood Rd/Gladstone Ave: 30% drop in calls for service.
 - 700-block of Johnson St: 20% drop in calls for service.
 - ▣ March
 - Richmond Ave/Leighton Rd: no disorder calls, 63% drop in property crime.
