2016 Action Plan Progress

Notable Milestones:

- Completion of CALUC review
- Expansion of Development Tracker
 - ✓ Heritage alteration permits with variances added
- Public open house and CALUC information meeting for Schedule 'C' – Off-Street Parking Regulations update
- Local area planning progress:
 - ✓ Burnside-Gorge Neighbourhood Plan nearing completion
 - ✓ Fairfield, Gonzales and Victoria West planning underway

2016 Action Plan Progress

Notable Milestones (continued)

- Process improvements underway and nearing completion that will improve development application and building permit application processes
- Target timelines for review of major permits (aiming for 90%) were met 81% of the time (average turnaround time of 11 days) in 2016
- Target timelines for development applications (aiming for 75%) were met 89.9% of the time for applications completed between June 1 to December 31, 2016

- Opportunity to update participants on progress made since 2016
- Different format proposed in the form of smaller, more focused sessions
- Dig deeper into specialized topics
- Find solutions for some Action Plan items next in line for implementation
