Pacific Coach Lines Ltd. has applied to the Passenger Transportation Board (PTB) to reduce minimum route frequency of inter-city bus service between Victoria and Vancouver (via the Swartz Bay and Tsawwasen Ferry Terminals), mainly in the off-season.

Pacific Coach seeks to reduce minimum service to 3 trips daily in each direction (off-peak season) and 3 trips daily (each direction) for stops at the Vancouver International Airport (year-round). At present, the minimums are 5 trips daily in each direction.
