




Purpose

 Recommendations for streamlining regulations to encourage participation in the Rainwater Management Incentive Program.



Background

 Some practices may need to comply with zoning regulations









Background

Others may require a DP or HAP











Key Issues

- Regulations and approval processes = potential barrier to Incentive Program participation
- 2. Processing of DPs and HAPs may require significant resources
- 3. Without oversight, potential negative impacts on adjacent properties or the public realm



Analysis

Potential Zoning Considerations:

- Cisterns and compliance with setbacks, site coverage and parking requirements
- Rooftop cisterns and compliance with height regulations



Analysis

 Development Permit/ Heritage Alteration Permit Considerations:

- Landscaping-related projects and green roofs
- Cisterns, particularly in visible locations (e.g. front yards and rooftops)



Recommendation

- a) Exempt landscaping-related projects, green roofs and cisterns from requiring a DP or HAP
- b) Exempt rooftop cisterns from height regulations
- c) Clarify that cisterns comply with zoning setbacks, site coverage and parking requirements
- d) Distribute information for placement and screening of cisterns
