Participants at the Parking Open House were invited to write down their ideas on how to improve downtown parking on post-it notes and to place them on a display panel. The Open House was open to the public, but downtown businesses were invited by the City of Victoria and the Downtown Victoria Business Association.

IDEAS:

- This past weekend stat Monday, cars were there since Sunday. Could not shop on Fort Street. Start enforcement at 1pm on Stat Holidays.
- Charge at night and lower rates. Why punish day business?
- Sunday parking start enforcement at 1pm to 6pm.
- Fort Street 800 block should be 90 minutes. The change will make it impossible.
- 800 Fort keep the 20 minute meters!!
- Thanks – increase parking time around provincial museum for visitors.
- Increase time to 120 minutes or maybe more at provincial museum
- 1 hr free at parkades not long enough. Perhaps 2 hrs free?
- More visible on-street bicycle parking. Bike Corrals in a few places. Businesses want them.
- City Siemens Meters should be used at private and public parkades.
- Need more parkades!
- Cycling corrals (10+ bikes) high use, high visibility locations

- European model in Austria, main highway has signs that list # of parkade spaces.
- Do something about aggressive enforcement.
- Review of commercial, loading, passenger, taxi, etc. zones, please.
- Parking guidance system! Thanks!
- Please consider cameras for parkades.
- Marriott Hotel taxi stand, please.
- Parkades short-term at lower levels please
