Subject: Application for a permanent change to extend Hours of Sale in relation to a
Retail Store Liquor Licence, for **Spinnakers Beer & Wine Merchants**, 425
Simcoe Street, Licence No. 195483

Executive Summary

The purpose of this report is to seek direction from Council in response to a request from the business owner to amend a provision of a Section 219 Covenant Agreement (FB147506) for Spinnakers Beer and Wine Merchants at their Retail Store Liquor Licensed business located at 425 Simcoe Street to enable a one hour extension to their hours of operation.

The current hours for liquor sales are from 0900h (9:00am) to 2200h (10:00pm) seven (7) days per week. If approved, the hours of operation for liquor sales would be 0900h (9:00am) to 2300h (11:00pm) seven days a week.

Recommendation

That Council, after conducting a review with respect to noise and community impacts regarding the application to amend liquor sales hours for the Retail Store Liquor Licensed business of **Spinnakers Beer and Wine Merchants**, Liquor License No. 195483, located at 425 Simcoe Street, approves:

1. The application of **Spinnakers Beer and Wine Merchants** to operate their Retail Store Liquor Licensed business during the hours of 0900h (9:00am) to 2300h (11:00pm) daily.
2. In so doing, Council instructs the Corporate Administrator to:
 - (a) Amend the current section 219 (*Land Title Act*) Covenant Agreement (FB147506) in place for the property legally described as "Lot 1 Beckley Farm, Victoria City, Plan 26705" and commonly known as "425 Simcoe Street" by striking out "10 o'clock p.m." in section 3.1 of Part 2 of the Covenant Agreement and substituting in its place "11 o'clock p.m.", and
 - (b) Notify the General Manager of the Liquor Control and Licensing Branch (LCLB) of this decision so that the LCLB can amend the provincial Retail Store Liquor Licence accordingly.



(Six (6) letters were received, 1 from the applicant, 2 from persons supporting the request, 2 from persons not supporting the request and 1 from the JBNA suggesting Council defer this decision. In addition, a petition from the applicant with 320 signatures in support of the application was received.)

Purpose

The purpose of this report is to seek Council direction regarding an application by Spinnakers Beer and Wine Merchants, in relation to their Retail Store Liquor Licensed business located at 425 Simcoe Street to extend their hours of liquor sales from 10:00PM to 11:00PM seven (7) days per week. The current hours for liquor sales are from 0900h (9:00am) to 2200h (10:00pm) seven days per week.

Background

Spinnakers Beer and Wine Merchants is located at 425 Simcoe St. and is part of the James Bay Square commercial area. Spinnakers first applied to open a Liquor Retail Store at this location in 2007 by applying to have the property rezoned to allow this use. The application was denied by Council at that time as a result of community concerns regarding potential noise and nuisance from the liquor retail sales business. The matter came back before Council for reconsideration in March 2008. At this time the rezoning was approved as the result of an agreement that the business to be subject to a *Land Title Act* Section 219 Restrictive Covenant (Covenant Agreement FB147506) that prohibited the sales of spirits in the store and restricted the hours of operation from 9:00AM to 10:00PM, 7 days a week.

In 2011, the owner of Spinnakers requested Council to consider removing Section 2.1 of the Covenant Agreement that disallowed the sale of spirits. In March 2011, after holding a public hearing Council agreed to remove that clause of the Covenant Agreement and Spinnakers was allowed to sell spirits, but was still required to close the retail store at 10:00PM nightly.

At the time the store was first opened in 2008, the other large retail sales outlet in the square (Thrifty Foods) had business closing hours of 10:00pm. Since that time, the Thrifty Foods outlet has changed its operating hours to be open 24 hours a day. As a result, Spinnakers is requesting that the covenant provision respecting closing hours reflect the provincial standard for operating hours for their business. If approved, the Retail Store Liquor Licensed business would be open for liquor sales from 0900h (9:00am) to 2300h (11:00pm) seven days per week. No other aspect of the business delivery would change if this request is approved. Full rationale for Spinnaker's request is outlined in their letter attached to this Report.

Location

Official Community Plan:

- The OCP designates the property within Development Permit Area 5 (Large Urban Village).
- The area is designated within the James Bay Village which is the centre of the James Bay neighbourhood and located at a five-point intersection of Menzies, Simcoe and Toronto Streets. It is a commercial node that includes mixed uses, community services and a park, containing a variety of building ages, types and forms.

Zoning:

- The property is zoned C1-JB, James Bay Extended Commercial District.
- This zone permits a mix of uses including restaurants, call centres, clubs, theatres, retail sales, banks, professional offices and office space. Liquor retail sales outlets are also specifically included provided they do not exceed 200m² of floor space.
- Off-street parking is required for commercial properties in this zone and the current parking meets the zoning regulation requirements.

Neighbourhood Compatibility:

- Surrounding land uses include: retail, restaurants, personal services and offices.
- Residential uses are permitted in this zone and it is noted that multiple dwellings are already located on site with six floors of apartment units directly above the existing liquor store. The liquor store fronts Simcoe Street and the property opposite is occupied by multiple dwellings (in the 13 storey Lord Simcoe apartment building) and is zoned R3-H: High Density Multiple Dwelling District.
- The subject property is in the Intermediate District pursuant to the terms of the Noise Bylaw although the site is adjacent to a Quiet District.

The Sustainable Planning & Community Development Department has no objection to the application as the use is permitted.

Liquor Control and Licensing Branch

The General Manager of the provincial Liquor Control and Licensing Branch (LCLB) issues liquor licences under the authority of the *Liquor Control and Licensing Act* and regulations. With respect to the retail sales of liquor, all Retail Store Liquor Licensed businesses throughout the province are allowed to sell liquor products between 0900h (9:00am) and 2300h (11:00pm) seven (7) days per week. Amending section 3.1 of the Section 219 Covenant Agreement (FB147506) to 11:00PM would mean that the provincial opening hours would apply to the Retail Store Liquor Licence for Spinnakers.

Relevant Policy / Bylaw

- a) Liquor Licensing Policy;
- b) Liquor Licensing Fee Bylaw.

Issues and Analysis

This application is requesting a permanent change to the operating conditions so that the Retail Store Liquor Licensed business can be open until 2300h (11:00pm) daily.

As noted below, there has been only one complaint associated with the operation of this business filed with the City that was resolved quickly.

Within a 100 metre radius of Spinnakers Beer and Wine Merchants, there is 1 other Retail Store Liquor Licensed outlet, which is operated by the province. That store has operating hours of 0930h (9:30am) to 2100h (9:00pm), Monday through Saturday.

Bylaw Enforcement

The Bylaw and Licensing Services Division has no concerns with the application. There has been one complaint received about this business regarding excessive noise (from 2011) in relation to street performers at the premises. This complaint was quickly resolved by the business.

Engineering & Public Works Department

The Downtown Community Development Section has reviewed this application and has no concerns based upon their experience with other similar Retail Store Liquor Licensed businesses in the City that have an 11:00pm closing time as they have not created excess noise or nuisance concerns.

Police

The Police Department believes this specific change request would have minimal impact on noise and nuisance in the community. They have no concerns with this application being approved as requested.

Official Community Plan Consistency Statement

As the request by the applicant is congruent with the Zoning Regulation Bylaw requirements, this request, if approved, is consistent with the OCP.

Financial and Staff Capacity Assessment

Not applicable. This issue has no direct staffing or other resourcing impacts. As stated above, VicPD believes this change would have no impact on their resources.

Public Engagement and Consultation

In accordance with the City's Liquor Licensing Fee Bylaw and Liquor Licensing Policy, all owners and occupiers within 50 metres of the applicant's location were solicited by mail to provide input regarding this application (a total of 899 notices were mailed out to area residents and the James Bay Community Association). In addition, the business displayed a poster at the access points to their business for a 4 week period which also invited people to provide input to the City with respect to this application.

The results of this consultation are attached to this report.

Conclusions

The Retail Store Liquor Licensed business has been operating since 2008 with a positive compliance record. City staff from relevant Departments are either supportive of, or have no opposition to, the proposed change to extend the hours for liquor sales by 1 hour daily as requested by the applicant.

The increase in hours of service to 11:00pm is expected to have minimal impact on the community. Since the approval of original application in 2008 for this business, there has been a change in operating hours for other businesses in James Bay Square. There is apparently both strong feelings in the local community to both support this request as well as maintain the status quo. From a technical perspective the recommendation is supportable as it complies with the City's current liquor licensing policy (for the following reasons):

- the requested use is compatible with the neighbourhood;
- allowing an extra hour of liquor sales would be a positive economic benefit to the licensee;
- feedback from the local community indicates that the additional hour of liquor sales would be used by members of the local community;
- the business has a positive compliance record; and
- the request complies with existing City regulations governing this type of business.

Recommendation

That Council, after conducting a review with respect to noise and community impacts regarding the application to amend liquor sales hours for the Retail Store Liquor Licensed business of **Spinnakers Beer and Wine Merchants**, Liquor License No. 195483, located at 425 Simcoe Street, approves:

1. The application of **Spinnakers Beer and Wine Merchants** to operate their Retail Store Liquor Licensed business during the hours of 0900h (9:00am) to 2300h (11:00pm) daily.

2. In so doing, Council instructs the Corporate Administrator to:

- (a) Amend the current section 219 (*Land Title Act*) Covenant Agreement (FB147506) in place for the property legally described as "Lot 1 Beckley Farm, Victoria City, Plan 26705" and commonly known as "425 Simcoe Street" by striking out "10 o'clock p.m." in section 3.1 of Part 2 of the Covenant Agreement and substituting in its place "11 o'clock p.m.", and
- (b) Notify the General Manager of the Liquor Control and Licensing Branch (LCLB) of this decision so that the LCLB can amend the provincial Retail Store Liquor Licence accordingly.

Appendix 1 – Alternate Resolution

The following draft resolution has been prepared and is provided for Council should they decide to not support the request of Spinnakers Beer and Wine Merchants to increase their hours of business.

Resolution

That Council, after conducting a review with respect to noise and community impacts regarding the application to amend liquor sales hours for the Retail Store Liquor Licensed business of **Spinnakers Beer and Wine Merchants**, Liquor License No. 195483, located at 425 Simcoe Street, **does not approve**:

1. The application of **Spinnakers Beer and Wine Merchants** to operate their Retail Store liquor licensed business during the hours of 0900h (9:00am) to 2300h (11:00pm) daily, and
2. Reaffirms the decision to maintain the current Section 219 (*Land Title Act*) Covenant Agreement (FB147506) in place for the property legally described as "Lot 1 Beckley Farm, Victoria City, Plan 26705" and commonly known as "425 Simcoe Street" to ensure that the Retail Store liquor Licensed business continues to have authorized daily business hours between 0900h (9:00am) to 2200h (10:00pm) only.
3. In so doing, Council directs that staff are to notify the General Manager of the Liquor Control and Licensing Branch (LCLB) of this decision so that the LCLB can ensure they continue to issue the Retail Store liquor licence with the appropriate conditions.

TERMS OF INSTRUMENT – PART 2

SECTION 219 COVENANT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT IS DATED FOR REFERENCE the 31ST day of December, 2007

WHEREAS:

A. The Transferor, KANCO-JAMES BAY PROPERTIES LTD., is the registered owner of that certain parcel or tract of land described in Item 3 of Part 1 of this instrument (the "Land");

B. By the provisions of Section 219 of the *Land Title Act*, R.S.B.C 1996, c.250 (the "*Land Title Act*"), a covenant, whether of a negative or positive nature, in respect of the use of land, in favour of, *inter alia*, a municipal corporation, may be registered as a charge against the title to that land and is enforceable against the covenantor and its successors in title, even if the covenant is not annexed to the land owned by the covenantee.

C. The Transferor has agreed to grant to the Transferee a covenant pursuant to Section 219 of the *Land Title Act* to restrict use of the Land.

NOW THEREFORE THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSES that in consideration of the premises and of the mutual covenants contained in this Agreement and the sum of TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) lawful money of Canada now paid by the Transferee to the Transferor, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged by the Transferor, the Transferor and the Transferee hereby agree with each other as follows:

1.0 Interpretation

1.1 In this Agreement "Land" means any and all parts of the Land.

1.2 This Agreement shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws of British Columbia and the laws of Canada applicable in British Columbia.

1.3 Headings are for reference only and do not form part of this Agreement.

2.0 Restrictions on Use of the Land - Deleted June 7, 2011 - CA 2045607

~~2.1. Notwithstanding any greater or broader uses permitted by the Transferee's Zoning Bylaw, from time to time, the Transferor covenants and agrees that no part of the Land may be used or suffered to be used by its owner or occupier as an establishment that engages in the sale of alcoholic spirits (meaning any alcoholic liquor obtained primarily by the process of distillation) for off-premises consumption.~~

3.0 Hours of Operation

3.1 The Transferor covenants and agrees that for such time as the Land is used for a Licensee Retail Store licensed under the Liquor Control and Licensing Act, notwithstanding the Liquor Control and Licensing Branch's authority to restrict hours of operation of the Licensee Retail Liquor Store, the hours of operation of the said Licensee Retail Store shall be limited to a closing time of not later than 10 o'clock p.m., and an opening time of no earlier than 9 o'clock a.m., seven days per week.

4.0 General

4.1 The Transferor shall indemnify and keep indemnified from any and all claims, causes of action, suits, demands, fines, penalties, costs or expenses, or legal fees whatsoever which anyone has or may have against the Transferee or which the Transferee incurs as a result of any loss or damage or injury, including economic loss, arising out of or connected with this Agreement or with the Transferor's breach of any covenant contained in this Agreement.

4.2 The Transferor hereby releases and forever discharges the Transferee of and from any claims, causes of action, suits, demands, fines, penalties, costs or expenses or legal fees whatsoever which the Transferor can or may have against the Transferee for any loss or damage or injury, including economic loss, that the Transferor may sustain or suffer arising out of or connected with this Agreement or with the Transferor's breach of any covenant contained in this Agreement.

4.3 Nothing contained or implied in this Agreement shall prejudice or affect the rights and powers of the Transferee in the exercise of its functions under any public or private statutes, bylaws, orders and regulations, all of which may be fully and effectively exercised in relation to the Lands as if this Agreement had not been executed and delivered by the Transferor.

4.4 The Transferor and the Transferee agree that the enforcement of this Agreement shall be entirely within the discretion of the Transferee and that the execution and registration of this covenant against the title to the Land shall not be interpreted as creating any duty on the part of the Transferee to the Transferor or to any other person to enforce any provision or the breach of any provision of this Agreement.

4.5 The Transferor covenants and agrees for itself, its heirs, executors, successors and assigns, that it will at all times perform and observe the requirements and restrictions hereinbefore set out and they shall be binding upon the Transferor as personal covenants only during the period of the Transferor's ownership of the Land.

4.6 At the Transferor's expense, the Transferor will do or cause to be done all acts reasonably necessary to grant priority of registration and interest for this Agreement and the Section 219 covenant it creates over all registered and pending charges and encumbrances of a financial nature against the Land, save and except those as have been specifically approved in writing by the Transferee or have been granted in favour of the Transferee.

4.7 The Transferee covenants and agrees that if the municipal council for the Transferee, within six (6) months of the date of registration of this Covenant, fails or refuses to give third reading and final adoption to its proposed Zoning Regulation Bylaw, Amendment Bylaw No. 07-64, that the Transferee shall, at the request of the Transferor, execute a discharge of this Covenant which discharge shall be prepared and registered at the expense of the Transferor.

4.8 Time is of the essence of this Agreement.

4.9 This Agreement shall enure to the benefit of and be binding upon the parties hereto and their respective heirs, executors, successors and permitted assigns.

4.10 The waiver by a party of any failure on the part of the other party to perform in accordance with any of the terms or conditions of this Agreement is not to be construed as a waiver of any future or continuing failure, whether similar or dissimilar.

4.11 Wherever the singular, masculine and neuter are used throughout this Agreement, the same is to be construed as meaning the plural or the feminine or the body corporate or politic as the context so requires.

4.12 It is mutually understood, acknowledged and agreed by the parties hereto that the Transferee has made no representations, covenants, warranties, guarantees, promises or agreements (oral or otherwise) with the Transferor other than those contained in this Agreement.

4.13 The restrictions and covenants herein contained shall be covenants running with the Land and shall be perpetual, and shall continue to bind all of the Land when subdivided, and shall be registered in the Land Title Office pursuant to Section 219 of the *Land Title Act* as covenants in favour of the Transferee as a first charge against the Land.

4.14 No remedy under this Agreement is to be deemed exclusive but will, where possible, be cumulative with all other remedies at law or in equity.

4.15 This Agreement is to be construed in accordance with and governed by the laws applicable in the Province of British Columbia.

4.16 If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase in this Agreement is for any reason held to be invalid by the decision of a Court of competent jurisdiction, the invalid portion shall be severed and the decision that is invalid shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Agreement.

This letter is to formally request that Council give consideration to amending a restrictive covenant over the property known as 435 Simcoe Street, currently occupied and operating as Spinnakers Spirit Merchants, James Bay Square. The request is to remove the restrictive covenant that prohibits sales after 10PM daily.


The initiative to develop this property as a private liquor retail store came as a result of Provincial government policy changes that called on holders of Liquor Primary licenses to open new liquor retail outlets throughout the province. We sought to become part of the James Bay village center with a location on Simcoe Street, at sidewalk level and in a shopping plaza which also contained a major retail grocery store. The premises at 435 Simcoe were secured in early 2005.

As the land use and licensing application processes moved through processes with Victoria City Council, concerns were raised over potential proliferation of alcohol sales and degradation of social and public safety issues within the immediate neighbourhood. To ameliorate such concerns, a restrictive covenant was entered into between the building owners and the City of Victoria, placing a restrictive covenant on the property restricting the hours of sale to a maximum of 10PM daily, a time which then coincided with the closing hours of Thrifty Foods, the property's anchor grocery tenant.

Approximately a year ago, Thrifty Foods changed their hours of operation to a 24/7 format where they are now open 24 hours per day, seven days per week. This letter is a request to remove the restrictive covenant covering hours of operation, to allow the Provincial regulations governing the hours of liquor retail to apply in the case of this store. If this request were to be granted, the hours of operation would extend to 11PM daily, the same as virtually every other private liquor retail store in the City of Victoria and indeed the rest of the Province.

Please advise as to what we might provide in the way of formal application and support material for this consideration to move forward.

**Re: Application for Permanent Change to a retail store liquor licence
Spinnakers Wine and Beer Merchants 425 Simcoe Street**

We are aware of the application for a further easing of the covenant with which Spinnakers obtained zoning for its retail operations at 425 Simcoe.

You will recall that the store was originally to offer locally made and specialty items only. This was altered a couple of years ago to include 'spirits' and a more general range of products. With a BC liquor Store outlet less than a block away and Thrifty Foods in the same building as Spinnakers, the 5-corners area is well served with retail sales. In addition, Swiftsure has a cold beer and wine store on Quebec Street and Laurel Point has the right to either open or sell rights for another liquor store in James Bay.

The Provincial Government recently announced that alcohol sales may be permitted in grocery stores. We ask that any decision on the further easing of the Spinnakers covenant be tabled until the change in provincial policy is developed and in place. The "Store-within-a-Store" program may have restrictive hours that residents and Council may wish to consider when reviewing other liquor licence requests such as the current request from Spinnakers.

Covenants should not be lifted easily. Although Spinnakers is known as a 'good' retail operation that respects its neighbours, a subsequent owner of the property may not be. The covenant is attached to the property, not the owner. The neighbourhood has experienced unpleasant shifts of ownerships in the past.
