RECOMMENDATION

That Council:

- Rescind second reading of the Zoning Regulation Bylaw, Amendment Bylaw (No. 1083) Bylaw No. 17-010.
- 2. Give second reading to the amended Zoning Regulation Bylaw, Amendment Bylaw (No. 1083) 17-010, attached as Schedule A.

BACKGROUND

On February 23, 2017, Council gave second reading to Zoning Regulation Bylaw, Amendment Bylaw (No. 1083) No. 17-010. Since that time, it came to staff's attention that there is a need to clarify in the bylaw: under what circumstances the regulations of the new zone would be applied, section number cross-referencing, as well as, vehicle parking and setback regulations.

These deficiencies have been corrected in Schedule A. attached.

In order for the rezoning application to advance for consideration at a Public Hearing, Council must rescind second reading and give the revised bylaw, Zoning Regulation Bylaw, Amendment Bylaw (No. 1083) No. 17-010 second reading at the March 23, 2017 Council meeting.
