

HERITAGE PROPERTY PROTECTION, AMENDMENT BYLAW (No. 2)

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA

The purpose of this Bylaw is to update the Heritage Property Protection Bylaw to reflect evolving land use application processes while preserving the ability of the City to ensure that properties worthy of protection continue to be protected. This bylaw also updates the section references to the 2016 revision of the *Local Government Act*.

Under its statutory powers, including sections 604 and 605 of the *Local Government Act*, the Council of the City of Victoria, in an open meeting assembled, enacts the following provisions:

Title

- 1 This Bylaw may be cited as the "Heritage Property Protection, Amendment Bylaw (No. 2)".

Amendments

- 2 The Heritage Property Protection Bylaw (95-62) is amended:
 - (1) in the preamble by striking out the numbers "960" and "961" and replacing them with "604" and "605" respectively;
 - (2) in section 2(b), by striking out the number "967" and replacing it with "611";
 - (3) in section 3, by
 - (a) inserting the words "in a manner that is inconsistent with the *Standards and Guidelines of the Conservation of Historic Places in Canada*" immediately after the words "an alteration,";
 - (b) adding the word "and" at the end of paragraph (a);
 - (c) replacing the semicolon at the end of paragraph (b) with a period; and
 - (d) deleting sub-paragraph (c).
 - (4) in section 4, by deleting the number "972" and replacing it with the number "617".

Effective Date

- 3 This Bylaw comes into force upon adoption.
