**Subject:** Pesticide Use Reduction Bylaw – Correction to Recent Adoption

**RECOMMENDATION**

That Council:

- a. rescind adoption and third reading of the Pesticide Use Reduction Bylaw, Amendment Bylaw, No. 1 (16-066) and;
- b. give third reading to the amended Pesticide Use Reduction Bylaw, Amendment Bylaw, No. 1 (16-066) attached as Schedule A.

**BACKGROUND**

On September 8, 2016, Council adopted the Pesticide Use Reduction Bylaw, Amendment Bylaw, No. 1 (16-066). While preparing a consolidation for posting to the web, it came to staff's attention that the amendment bylaw listed an incorrect bylaw number as the parent bylaw, for amending.

This error is corrected in Schedule A, attached.

In order to adopt a corrected version of the Pesticide Use Reduction Bylaw, Amendment Bylaw, No. 1, Council must rescind third reading and adoption and give the revised bylaw third reading at the January 12, 2017 Council meeting and adoption at the January 26, 2017 Council meeting.
