RECOMMENDATION

That Council:

- 1. Rescind third reading of the Ticket Bylaw, Amendment Bylaw (No.9) given July 28, 2016,
- 2. Give third reading to the proposed Ticket Bylaw, Amendment Bylaw (No.9), as amended.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

On July 28, 2016, Council gave three readings to the proposed Ticket Bylaw, Amendment Bylaw (No.9) that added the new Marijuana-Related Business Regulation Bylaw and related offences.

On September 8, 2016, Council gave the direction "that all references to marijuana in Bylaw No. 16-058. No. 16-061 and No. 16-059 be replaced with the word "cannabis"". The three bylaws referenced are all those related to the regulation of medical cannabis. While Ticket Bylaw, Amendment Bylaw, (No.9), No. 16-069, was not included in this motion, it is affected by the change, and has been amended and attached for Council consideration. Since it had previously been given three readings, third reading needs to be rescinded and given instead to the revised proposed bylaw. Adoption will be added to the agenda for the next Council meeting, in order to ensure the proper ticketing authorities are in place for the new cannabis regulations.

CONCLUSIONS

The proposed Ticket Bylaw, Amendment Bylaw (No.9), attached as Appendix A, includes updated reference to the new "Cannabis-Related Business Regulation Bylaw" throughout.
