First Nation / Local Government

- Staff Review:
 - Police, Bylaw, Planning, Community Development and Engineering
 - Zoning regulation, liquor policy and the Liquor Licencing Fee Bylaw
- Public Notification and Comment:
 - Notice Posted at entrance to establishment
 - Mailed Notice to within 100m of establishment
 - 30 days to provide comment

Local Government provides a resolution with comment on:

- Potential for Noise
- Potential for Impact on the Community



Recommendation

That Council direct staff to:

1. Notify the Liquor Licensing Agency that Council supports the application for the structural change increasing the occupant load to 500 persons.
