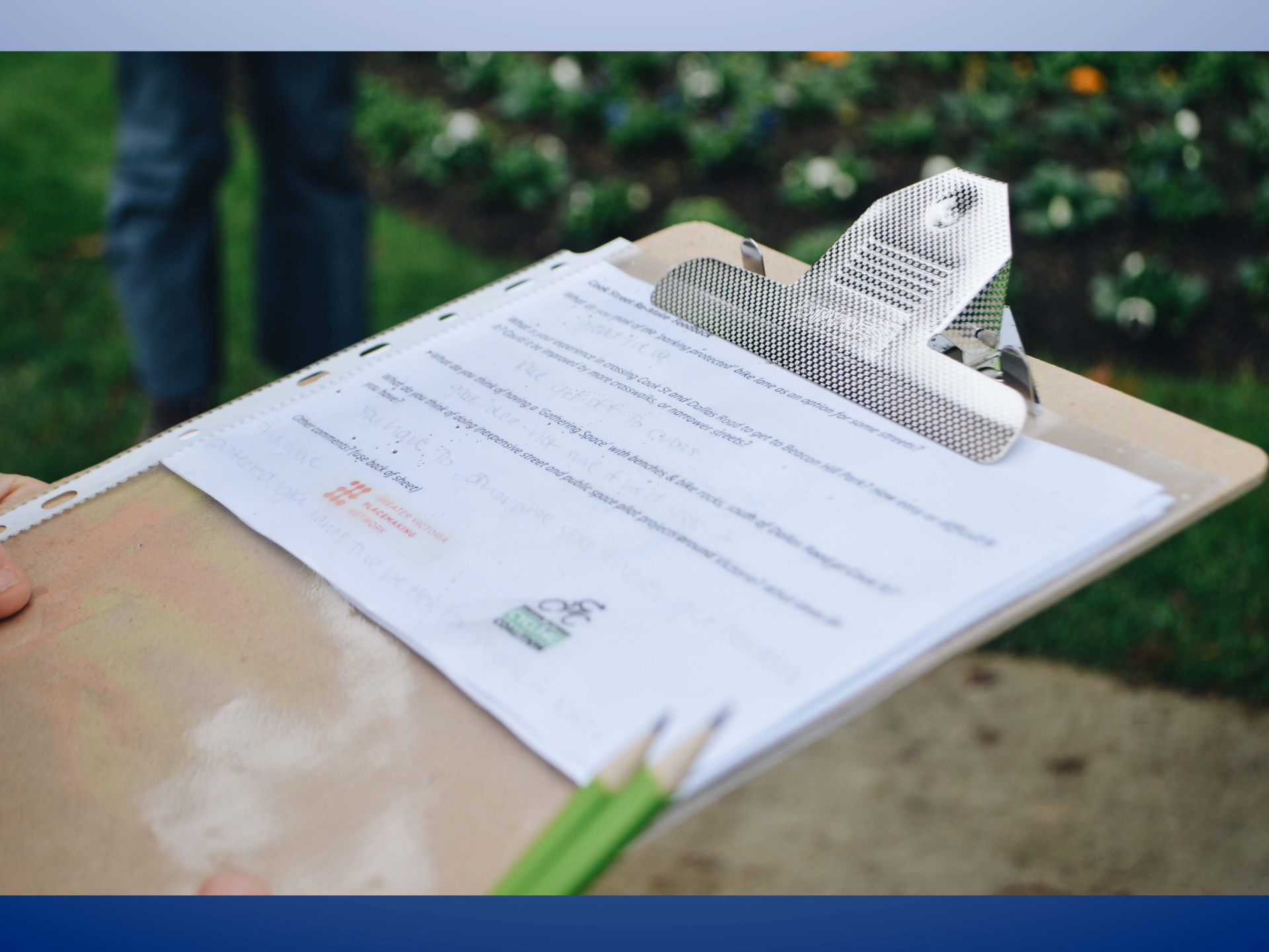

Recommendations

5. City integrate longer term pilots into #Biketoria plan
6. City conduct longer term pilot of parking-protected bike lanes & narrowed vehicle lanes on city arterial(s)
