## A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA

The purposes of this bylaw are to amend the Sanitary Sewer and Stormwater Utilities Bylaw to make section 24 (Codes of Practice) of the Sanitary Sewer and Stormwater Utilities Bylaw applicable to businesses that discharge stormwater directly into a watercourse or waterway, to amend the street and sidewalk cleaning component of the stormwater user fee that is payable by the owners of Low Density Residential properties, and to make other miscellaneous amendments to the Sanitary Sewer and Stormwater Utilities Bylaw.

Under its statutory powers, including sections 8 and 194 of the *Community Charter*, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Victoria enacts the following provisions:

#### Title

- 1 This Bylaw may be cited as the "SANITARY SEWER AND STORMWATER UTILITIES BYLAW, AMENDMENT BYLAW (NO.3)".
- 2 Bylaw No. 14-071, the Sanitary Sewer and Stormwater Utilities Bylaw, is amended as follows:
  - (a) In the definition of "Qualified Professional" in section 2(1), by inserting ", architect" immediately after the word "applied scientist".
  - (b) In the definition of "Watercourse" in section 2(1), by deleting the word "or" at the end of subsection (a), by adding the word "or" at the end of subsection (b), and by adding the following as subsection (c):
    - "(c) a waterway,"
  - (c) In section 2(1), by adding the following definition immediately after the definition of "Watercourse":

"Waterway" includes the Inner Harbour, the Gorge Waterway, and all other marine waters that are within the boundaries of the City.'

- (d) In each of sections 24(1), 24(2) and 24(3) by adding the words "or watercourse" immediately after the words "municipal stormwater system".
- (e) In section 28, by adding the following as section 28(3A) immediately after section 28(3):
  - "(3A) Despite sections 28(2)(b) and 28(3), the street cleaning factor for a property classified as Low Density Residential shall be calculated as if each highway abutting that property were classified as a Local Street."
- (f) In section 10 of Schedule "A", in item 2.A, Street/Sidewalk Cleaning Factor, of the Stormwater User Fee Calculation Table, by increasing the fee (per meter) for Local Streets from \$1.08 to \$1.57.

- (g) In section 11(b) of Schedule "A", by renaming the table that is titled "Rainwater Management Credit Table – Multi-Family Residential, Civic/Industrial and Commercial/Industrial Properties" to "Rainwater Management Credit Table – Multi-Family Residential, Civic/Institutional and Commercial/Industrial Properties".
- (h) In section 11(b) of Schedule "A", by deleting the table that follows the new title "Rainwater Management Credit Table – Multi-Family Residential, Civic/Institutional and Commercial/Industrial Properties", and by inserting the table that is attached to this bylaw as Schedule 1.
- (i) In the BMP (Design and Construction Requirements) Table set out in section 11(c) of Schedule "A", at the end of Note "3", by inserting the words:

"Green Roofs must be designed by and installed under the supervision of a Qualified Professional who is a professional architect or structural engineer."

- (j) By deleting Schedule "F", the Code of Practice Registration Form, and substituting the Schedule "F" that is attached to this bylaw as Schedule 2.
- (k) In Schedule "G", Code of Practice for Construction and Development Activities, by inserting the words "and section 8(3)(j)" after the words "section 8(3)(a)" in section 1.1, and by inserting the words "or watercourse" after the words "municipal stormwater system" in each of sections 1.1, 1.3(h), 1.3(i), 1.3 (k), 2.1, 2.2, 2.3, 2.5, 3.1, in the first sentence of section 3.5, and in section 3.7.
- In Schedule "H", Code of Practice for Automotive and Parking Lot Activities, by inserting the words "and section 8(3)(j)" after the words "section 8(3)(a)" in section 1.1, and by inserting the words "or watercourse" after the words "municipal stormwater system" in each of sections 1.1, 1.2(i), 2.1, 2.2, 2.3, 2.4(a), 2.7, 2.8. 3.1, and in the first sentence of section 3.5.
- (m) In Schedule "I", Code of Practice for Recreation Facilities, by inserting the words "and section 8(3)(j)" after the words "section 8(3)(a)" in section 1.1, and by inserting the words "or watercourse" after the words "municipal stormwater system" in each of sections 1.1, 1.3(e), 2.1, 2.2, in the first sentence of section 3.5, and in section 3.6.
- (n) In Schedule "J", Code of Practice for Outdoor Storage Yard Operations, by inserting the words "and section 8(3)(j)" after the words "section 8(3)(a)" in section 1.1, and by inserting the words "or watercourse" after the words "municipal stormwater system" in each of sections 1.1, 1.2(e), 1.3(c), 1.3(h), 2.1, 2.2, 2.3, 2.8, 2.9, and in the first sentence of section 3.5.
- (o) In Schedule "K", Code of Practice for Recycling Operations, by inserting the words "and section 8(3)(j)" after the words "section 8(3)(a)" in section 1.1, and by inserting the words "or watercourse" after the words "municipal stormwater system" in each of sections 1.1, 1.3(g), 2.1, 2.2, 2.3, 2.8, 2.9, and in the first sentence of section 3.5.

3 This bylaw comes into effect on January 1, 2016.
