The BC Francophone Youth Council, in partnership with the Ministry of Canadian Heritage and the Province of BC, Minister of Community, Sport and Cultural Development, is organizing in Victoria, from **January 15th to 18th 2015**, its eighteenth annual British Columbia Francophone Youth Parliament (Parlement jeunesse francophone de la Colombie-Britannique or PJFCB).

For the past eighteen years, B.C. In 2016, we will continue the experience by offering the youth the possibility to get involved into four different ways: bill debate, civic participation, media and pages.

Welcoming over 110 participants in Victoria, hailing from different parts of British Columbia, gets more expensive each and every year. In order to insure the future of the institution that is the French Youth Parliament of British Columbia and to improve the experience we're giving to our , we 'd like to request a \$2000 funding from the City of Victoria.
