A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA

The purpose of this Bylaw is to designate the exterior of the building known as the Customs House (1914), located at 816 Government Street and 811-813 Wharf Street, as protected heritage property.

Under its statutory powers, including section 967 of the *Local Government Act*, the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of Victoria enacts the following provisions:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "HERITAGE DESIGNATION (816 GOVERNMENT STREET AND 811-813 WHARF STREET) BYLAW".
2. The exterior of the building known as the Customs House (1914), located on the lands with civic address 816 Government Street and 811-813 Wharf Street, and legally described as:
